**DECLARATION OF DANIEL R. KARON IN SUPPORT OF PLAINTIFFS'
UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR SERVICE AWARD TO CLASS REPRESENTATIVE AND

I, Daniel R. Karon, hereby declare as follows:

1. I am a partner in the law firm Karon LLC, one of Class Counsel. I respectfully submit this Declaration in support of Plaintiffs' Unopposed Motion for Service Award to Class Representative and Award of Attorneys' Fees and Costs to Class Counsel in connection with the services rendered in this lawsuit and the proposed class action settlement with Defendant.

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2. The statements herein are true to the best of my personal knowledge, information, and belief based on Plaintiffs' counsel's books and records and information received from their attorneys and staff.
